WHAT WE STAND FOR

THROUGHOUT THE RESORT:

- Replaced over 3,000 fluorescent lightbulbs with LED lightbulbs around the resort
- Everyday the trash from the resort is sorted and recycled 120 tons of paper annually 720 tons of cardboard annually 90 tons of Plastic annually 480 tons of glass annually
- Electric car chargers in parking garage
- Six Art-O-Mat machines created from refurbished cigarette machines
- Guests have the option to order glasses of filtered water from AquaHealth instead of bottled water, reducing plastic bottle waste by approximately 30%

HOUSEKEEPING

The Cosmopolitan partnered with Rock and Wrap It Up and The Global Soap Project to repurpose hotel room amenities back in to communities that need it the most, as well as repurpose waste from events the resort participates in from around the country

- An estimated 3,000 wire hangers are recycled every day from CoStar uniforms and hotel rooms
- Thousands of old pillows and blankets are donated to the local animal shelter each year
- Out of circulation quest towels used as rags

BANQUETS AND AV

- Disposable utensils and plates used during banquet functions are made from bamboo
- Our leftover food product is donated to the Las Vegas Rescue Mission, an organization that feeds several hundred homeless people each day.
- Lamp tracker to recycle batteries, lamps/bulbs and other consumable items containing mercury.
- All Audio Visual equipment is compliant with either Energy Star or RoHS (Restriction of Hazardous Substances)
- Pads of paper and water station cups are made from recyclable materials
- All meeting space lights are on timers to go off overnight and when no functions are scheduled
